HAZARDS

Assisting the spread of COVID -19 for Members, Volunteers and the public

If controls are not considered then we may increase the risk of COVID-19 spreading from the site. Toilets will be difficult to manage but with some simple controls in place the risk can be lowered to a reasonable level

Slips trips and falls

There is a minimal risk within this area

CONTROL MEASURES

Enhanced cleaning checks

The toilet area will be inspected regularly and all touch surfaces like door handles, locks, taps, will be sanitised. Checklist form to be completed and signed

Monitoring and supervision

The area to be monitored to ensure no gatherings is taking place

Accessing the area

Everyone to social distance when accessing area, toilets to be strictly **one person** at a time

Signage to the consumer

Maintain social distancing; Hand sanitising, wash your hands, **only one person at a time notice on toilet door**

Hand sanitiser available

At toilet points hand sanitiser will be available as will soap and hot water
